Unless otherwise stated, all vacancies are by appointment and approved by the City Council.

If you are interested in serving on one of the boards with the City of San Angelo, review the various boards, information, or contact the liaison listed in the brochure. Once you have selected a board, complete and sign the application. Applications can be obtained via our website or by calling our office. Airport Advisory Board

Purpose: To provide advice and recommendations to the City Council and Airport Manager in matters regarding operations and improvements at the Municipal Airport.

Membership: Consists of seven residents. ([Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Article 2.2500](#))

Animal Shelter Advisory Committee

Liaison: [Julie Vrana](#), Manager

Purpose: Provides advice regarding the animal shelter and animal welfare.

Membership: Consists of seven residents appointed by the City Council: one licensed veterinarian; one member shall own, operate or otherwise be employed by or in a business related to the production, sale, distribution or care of animals or livestock; two members shall represent a nonprofit animal interest group or groups whose membership is comprised primarily of citizens of the city and whose primary interest is the health and welfare of animals; and, the remaining three members shall be residents of the city and need not have any other affiliation, membership or association. Civic Events Board

Liaison: [Angelica Pena](#), Civic Events Manager

Purpose: An advisory board to the City Council and City Manager or his/her representatives as to matters of policy and to the as to administrative matters in regard to operation of the Convention Center, Coliseum, Auditorium, River Stage, and El Paseo de Santa Angela.

Membership: Consists of seven residents. ([Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Article 2.2200](#))

Civil Service Commission

Liaison: [Lisa Marley](#), Human Resources Director

Purpose: To administer Civil Service law in accordance with the Local Government Code.

Membership: Consists of three citizens appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council. ([Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Article 2.2400](#))

Construction Board of Appeals

Liaison: [Al Torres](#), Building Official

Purpose: This Board hears appeals and variances regarding building construction and related activities.

Membership: Consists of nine members: One architect or engineer, one commercial building contractor, one residential building contractor, one electrical contractor, one plumber, one mechanical contractor, one realtor, real estate inspector or real estate appraiser (member at large building industry), one homeowner, and one commercial business owner. ([Code of Ordinances, Chapter 4, Article 4.102](#))

Development Corporation

Purpose: Helps promote orderly and responsible economic development for the San Angelo area.

Membership: Consists of seven members. ([Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Article 2.3600](#))

Downtown Development Commission

Liaison: [Daniel Valenzuela](#), City Manager

Purpose: To advise the City Council with respect to matters of policy regarding downtown development. The Downtown Development Commission shall act as an advisory board to the City Council and City Manager on the redevelopment and revitalization of the downtown development district. The Downtown Development Commission shall have the power to make rules, regulations and by-laws for its own governance in conformity with the laws of the State of Texas. All of said rules, regulations and by-laws shall be approved by the city council.

Membership: Consist of seven members who seven (7) members who are stakeholders or have an active interest in the downtown development commission. The members shall be appointed as follows: (1) One (1) shall be a board member of the San Angelo Health Foundation.

Fairmount Cemetery Board

Membership: Consist of fourteen members who shall be self-perpetuating

Fort Concho Museum Board

Liaison: [Bob Bluthardt](#), Manager

Purpose: An advisory board for the operation and administration of all the Fort Concho Museum properties of the city; establishing goals, objectives and operational policies consistent with City Council policies and objectives; establishing guidelines for acquisition, restoration, preservation and maintenance; and, determining regulations, guidelines, and procedures for staffing, operation and programs for Fort Concho.

Membership: Consists of fifteen members. ([Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Article 2.2300](#))

Design & Historic Review Commission

Liaison: [Rebeca Guerra](#), Planning & Development Administrator

Purpose: To recommend, promote and approve the appropriateness and integrity of design review relating to historic preservation in the City and development along the Concho River designed by the City of San Angelo.

Membership: Consists of seven residents. Ex-officio members of the Commission shall include the Director of Planning and Development and the Chief Building Official of the City. ([Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Article 2.2800](#))

Investment Oversight Committee

Liaison: [Tina Bunnell](#), Finance Director

Purpose: To review and recommend changes to Investment Policy process; to review quarterly report; to review and adopt list of qualified brokers authorized to engage in investment transactions; to approve independent training provider as required by policy.

Membership: Consists of two City Council members, two citizens with experience as investment advisors or analysts, the City's independent auditor (as a non-voting member), and the City's Internal Auditor.

Metropolitan Planning Organization

Liaison: [Doray Hill](#), Interim MPO Director

Purpose: To create and provide general review of transportation plans within the city.

Membership: Membership is outlined in the by-laws and is limited to specific transportation and local government agency representatives.

Park Commission

Liaison: [Carl White](#), Parks & Recreation Director

Purpose: To provide general control and supervision of the parks within the city.

Membership: Consist of three residents designated by Park Commission and appointed by the City Council. ([City Charter, Section 65](#))

Planning Commission

Liaison: [Rebeca Guerra](#), Planning & Development Administrator

Purpose: To ensure planned and purposeful development of the City of San Angelo and its extraterritorial jurisdiction, to protect the integrity of our natural resources and neighborhoods, and to enforce State and local statues and ordinances.

Membership: Consists of seven residents appointed by the City Council. Ex Officio, non voting members of the Planning Commission shall be the Director of Planning and the Director of Public Works. ([Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Article 2.3100](#))

Public Art Commission

Liaison: [Carl White](#), Parks & Recreation Director

Purpose: To recommend selections and placements of art on city owned or controlled property.

Membership: Consists of seven members: a teacher or professor of art, a member of the San Angelo Cultural Affairs Council or the San Angelo Museum of Fine Arts; a member who is an artist, landscape architect, architect, engineer, or other type of design professional. Ex officio non-voting member who represents the Parks Department or Park commission as designated by the City Council or by the City Manager ([Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Article 2.4200](#))

Public Housing Authority

Liaison: [Daniel Valenzuela](#), City Manager

Purpose: In addition to duties delegated to the authority by the city council by contract agreement or policy directives, the Authority shall have the power to decide all issues which pertain to use of federal funds granted to the City of San Angelo by the Department of Housing and Urban Development which pertain to public housing.

Membership: Composed of five residents/qualified voters of the city appointed by the Mayor: one member shall be a tenant of a public housing project; three qualified residents of the community as follows: one architect, builder, or engineer; one member involved in banking, accounting, or financial services industry; and one member of the San Angelo Apartment Association or a similar association. ([Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Article 2.2700](#))

Parks & Recreation Advisory Board

Liaison: [Carl White](#), Parks and Recreation Director

Purpose: Provides advice and recommendations to the City Council in matters of oversight, policy and administration relating to City parks, recreation programs and facilities, with the exception of the Santa Fe Parks, for which the Parks Commission shall continue to act as the advisory commission to the City Council.

Membership: Consists of eight residents (eighth member from Park Commission). ([Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Article 2.2600](#))

Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone

Liaison: [Patrick Howard](#), Development Services Director

Purpose: To preserve the near and long-term integrity of the economic and social investment in the designated area and as needed to encourage additional new projects within the designated area of San Angelo.

Membership: Composed of fifteen members: (1) five shall be appointed by the City Council from those who own property within the zone of which four shall reside within Single Member Districts (SMD) #1, #3, #4, and #5 respectively; (2) one shall be appointed by the Tom Green County Commissioners from those who own property within the zone; (3) three shall be appointed by the City Council from those who own businesses within the zone; (4) two shall be appointed by the Tom Green County Commissioners from those who own businesses within the zone; (5) one member shall be appointed by Tom Green County; (6) one member shall be appointed by Goodfellow Air Force Base; (7) one member shall be appointed by Angelo State University; and (8) one member shall be appointed by San Angelo Independent School District. Water Advisory Board

Purpose: An advisory board to the City Council and City Manager on matters of water supply, conservation, reuse and other water related projects which the city council directs it to investigate, study, and make recommendations.

Membership: Consists of seven members. ([Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Article 2.3900](#))

Zoning Board of Adjustment

Liaison: [Rebeca Guerra](#), Planning & Development Administrator

Purpose: To consider variances, special exceptions, and appeals to the standards established in the Zoning Ordinances.

Membership: Consists of five members and two alternates. ([Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2, Article 2.3200](#))
